

# Moving Home Checklist

## Utilities

You will have to arrange for gas, electricity and telephone to be billed and if appropriate disconnected at your old address or, at the very least, for the relevant companies to be informed of the change. Meter readings will often be required and a week or more notice may be needed in the case of reconnections.

- Gas
- Electricity
- Telephone
- Water Company
- District Council (for Council Tax purposes)

## Removals

Prices vary a lot, and we suggest you get several estimates:

- Removals estimates
- Removals booked

## People to tell about your move

- Relatives and friends
- Your doctor and dentist
- The hospital, if you are receiving treatment
- Your children's school
- Your bank
- Your building society (in respect of savings accounts)
- Any credit/rental agencies (TV/video? Car?)
- National TV Licence Records Office, Bristol BS98 1TL  
(or take the Licence to any Post Office, for amendment)
- Motor Tax and Driving Licence, DVLC Swansea SA99 1BS
- The DSS, if you are receiving benefits, child benefit or state pension
- The Post Office – for mail redirect, but there is a charge
- Your newsagent
- Your milkman and other tradesman
- Your insurance companies (life, house, contents, car etc.)
